It was confiscated during the French Revolution, then divided and shared, and sold to various owners. The incredible building then fell into oblivion. Bruno Epailly is passionate about architecture, and he took on the best art craftsmen to reconstruct the abbey and turn it into a charming hotel.

The result of the renovations is just stunning: far from being a frozen, icy museum, the Abbaye de Maizières hotel offers guests a pure moment of history and romance.

Here every detail counts: breakfast is served by candlelight in the old monks' cellar, the guestrooms embrace the Beaunois roofs. The restaurant menu is inspired by the chef Cédric Burtin.... It's a decidedly unusual, exclusive and friendly place.
